Description: We meet to discuss the current status of different tools in the FairCoop ecosystem, how to improve these tools and to work together on progress with these developments. The program will be adapted to the participants and their skills. We will organise together the daily schedules, which will not only inculcate the working program but also food shopping, preparing meals, cleaning and social activities.

Type of Work: Participants will be discussing and working on task ranging from system administration to the various software stacks of the FairCoop ecosystem, covering different levels of experience and programming languages, graphics work and conceptual discussions of use cases.

Study Theme: During the whole Hackathon, we will together think and develop open source tools to improve FairEconomy.

Accommodation: We will intentionally live a simple and sustainable lifestyle during the Hackathon. The old art-nouveau villa houses up to 16-19 people and provides workshop rooms, the kitchen and social living space. There are dormitory rooms with beds, blankets and pillows. Meals will be vegan; The Hackathon participants are in charge of cooking and cleaning. Please be aware that the house is rather cold and there is a dog and a cat.

Language: We will speak English in the working groups. The people of the hosting community speak German, French, Serbo-Croatian and of course English. The local language is French and Swiss German.

Approximate Location: Mont-Soleil is a small hamlet at the edge of the Franche Montagne high-plateau in the Jura mountains of Switzerland. It is part of the community of St-Imier.

Notes: Organisation Description: The Hackathon is organised by FairCoop people at the Décentrale. The Décentrale is a cooperative and stands for transformation of the society towards self-organisation, self-empowerment, cooperation, sustainable green development, free education, fair economy, grassroots governance, and created the open Synergiehub project for that purpose. Therefore participants joining workshops, work camps and other gatherings at the Décentrale are expected to be aligned with the values of the Synergiehub project.

The usual contribution for a stay at the Décentrale is 16 Fairo/day (<https://fairo.exchange/>). People and groups are usually responsible for buying food supply. There will be a fundraising to try to support participants unable to cover these costs themselves.
